Pack 602 would like to thank you and your child for your interest in scouting. We want every boy to have the opportunity to be a part of scouting. We feel that scouting fosters self-confidence, respect, citizenship, teamwork and pride in a sense of accomplishment. Parents are a very important part of the scouting family. The more you are involved in your child's scouting experience, the more they will get out of scouting.

Den meetings are on Monday evenings at the Fletcher United Methodist Church, from 6:30-7:30 PM. You will get a detailed calendar periodically throughout the scout year from your child's den leader. You will find out where you will meet from your den leader.

Pack meetings are usually the last Monday of the month from 6:30 – 8:00 PM at the Fletcher United Methodist Church Fellowship Hall. A parent is required to attend pack meetings.

If there is no school due to a holiday or school is released early for inclement weather, then the den or pack meeting is cancelled.

Please stay out of the pre-school playground at the pre-school entrance. You may use Kate's Park before meetings with parental supervision. Please be aware that the park is not on church property and therefore, any accidents are not covered by the pack insurance policy.

Please make sure that your child is at their meeting place on time as there is only 1 hour and the den leaders begin the activities on time. Please make sure that your child is signed in before the meeting begins and signed out when they leave. Children are the responsibility of the parent until the meeting begins and after the meeting ends. If you want someone else to pick up your child, you must inform the den leader when dropping your child off. Tiger Cub parents are required to stay and participate in their child's activities. All parents are encouraged to stay and help the den meetings.

Pack 602 believes that all children should benefit from scouting and we will not turn away a potential scout due to the inability to afford the program. Anyone having difficulty meeting scout expenses, should talk to the Committee Chairperson, Cubmaster, or Den Leader.

If you have any concerns or questions, or if your child has any special needs, please see any leader.

Class A Uniform:

Scout shirt with appropriate badges/awards displayed

Neckerchief and slide

Blue/Green/Tan pants/shorts (clean, no cut-offs)

Socks

Shoes (No sandals, flip-flops, crocs, wheelies, etc)

Wearing a scout uniform is a very important part of scouting. Please help the Pack show respect for the uniform. Class "A" uniforms are required for pack meetings and should be worn to den meetings unless different arrangements are made by your child's den leader. Scouts not in Class "A" uniform at a pack meeting will not receive their awards. Shirts are to be clean and tucked in. A scout should show respect for their uniform. Pack T-shirts will be ordered in the fall and will be available for a small price.

Code of Conduct:

We want all boys to have fun and realize that "boys will be boys". In order to be fair to everyone, we ask that parents assist the den leaders by asking all boys to adhere to the guidelines below.

- * Show respect for parents, leaders, guests, staff and other scouts.
- * Do not interrupt a person who is speaking.
- * No foul or rude language.
- * No running inside buildings.
- * Keep hands to yourself; no pushing, wrestling, hitting, etc.

Discipline:

In order for all boys to get the most out of scouting, we must enforce the rules of conduct. The first time a boy breaks a rule, he gets a warning. The second time, the boy spends 5 minutes in Time Out. After 5 minutes the boy is asked if he is ready to return to the group. If a boy doesn't control himself in Time Out, he moves on to his third strike. When a Cub commits his third infraction of the Code of Conduct, he is excused from the meeting and must call a parent to come and get him.

Pack 602 adheres to "Two-Deep Leadership". At no time will an adult and a scout be alone. It is BSA policy that two adults be present at all times during Cub Scout Den meetings, lessons and activities. If there are not two adults available (parents or other adults), and it is not possible to join together with one of the other Dens, then the meeting or activity must be cancelled.

Leadership:

Pack 602 depends solely on parent volunteers to run the program. All of our leaders are parents of a scout. We would like very much for you to volunteer some of your time to help raise these boys in the “pack family”. If you can help, please see the Committee Chairperson to discuss possibilities. These are the leaders who work closely with the boys to progress them toward rank advancement.
